Our Panelists:

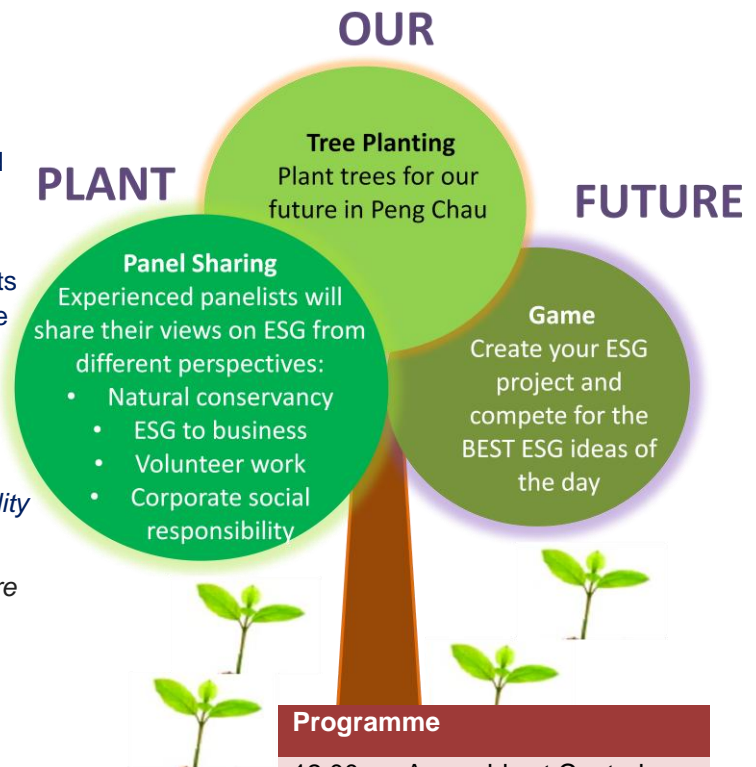
