Cannibalism effect in forensic accounting was initially conceptualised by Mr Benny K B Kwok in his expert testimony at a High Court action over ten years ago. Many new aspects have since evolved in forensic accounting as a derivative from litigations and alternative dispute resolutions. CPAs in forensics now provide expert assistance in cases of accounting irregularities, commercial crimes, financial wrongdoings, contract disputes, shareholders' deadlocks, royalty audits, land resumptions, business interruptions, personal injuries, estate contests, matrimonial breakdowns, professional negligence and business valuation. Whether it is a dispute, fraud, compliance issue or regulatory investigation, problems can quickly arise, spiral out of control and cause severe damages. Failure to appreciate the role played by CPAs in forensics can cost claimants, defendants and other stakeholders billions of dollars and even personal freedoms.

The speaker will compare the asset-based method with the earning-based method as well as the International Valuation Standards (IVS) in respect of business valuation for dispute and litigation purposes. Globalisation is changing the landscape of many professions, and the IVSs are being more widely adopted by authorities and institutions worldwide as the benchmark in valuation. The speaker will also reiterate the fundamentals of his business valuation paper published by the Law Society of Hong Kong in 2009.
