

Charity organizations' relief efforts for Nepalese quake victims

Organization	Usage of donation
<u>Unicef</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HK\$1,500: provide 7 first aid kits to treat the injured children. - HK\$2,850: provide 2 basic family water kits to enable children to drink and wash safely. - HK\$4,200: provide 3 sets of a ready-made education kit for 80 students
<u>World Vision</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provide food, water, tents, medical, hygiene kits and other basic necessities required to meet the urgent needs of survivors - Provision of counselling service to quake-affected people - Establishment of Child Friendly Space to help children relieve stress - Long-term rehabilitation projects in affected areas to help people regain their livelihoods and rebuild their communities
<u>Oxfam Hong Kong</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Deliver emergency supplies and sanitation facilities
<u>Hong Kong Red Cross</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provision of first aid services to the injured - Support to the main medical facilities in Kathmandu with blood supplies - Set up tents to shelter affected people
<u>Habitat for Humanity</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Target to distribute 20,000 emergency shelter kits to victims - Help carry out house-by-house damage assessments - Support to construct transitional shelters or new home construction
<u>Save for Children</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HK\$2,000: provide 6 kitchen sets to affected families to cook and eat hygienically, containing essential items such as pots, cutlery, mugs and plates - HK\$1000: provide emergency shelter kits to 4 families - HK\$500: provide 8 jerry cans for transporting and storing clean water
<u>The Salvation Army</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provide relief materials such as water, food and shelters - Provide counselling services to survivors
