## Computer Ethics: a risk and an anti-risk mechanism

Accountants rely on the computer. Failing to identify ethical issues surrounding the computer or neglecting these issues runs the risk of adverse consequences. In the case of accounting, it means a dangerously incomplete decision of audit, fatal damage to professional reputation, irrecoverable ruin of the business, to name a few. Stressing that economic efficiency is not enough (a risk) and social acceptability is equally important (anti-risk).

This seminar aims to alert the *netizens* including the accountants to the potential dangers of abusing the computer, and to introduce Computer Ethics and explain how it may help to reduce that abusive behavior. The topics will be expounded by such real live cases as the familiar Octopus saga, Snowden affair, “Do no evil (起你底)”, and others.
