



## HKICPA seminar: Key areas and common pitfalls in impairment test (re-run)

Impairment is a very important topic to all preparers, reviewers and users of financial statements. While impairment carries a negative connotation, under some circumstances an impairment test cannot be avoided even though there may not be an actual impairment. Whether an actual impairment exists and how much impairment loss should be recognized would require significant judgment by both the company and its auditor.

In this seminar, the speaker will share experience on some key areas in the performance of impairment test and common pitfalls from his previous role as a specialist reviewer of impairment test for audit purpose and his current role as a preparer of impairment test for clients.
