Auditing Impairment of Non-financial Assets - Key Judgmental Areas

Impairment of non-financial assets is an area of high estimation uncertainty and has long been one of the most critical and judgmental areas for auditors. The process of impairment assessment, including identifying cash-generating units, estimating the recoverable amount and recognizing an impairment loss, involves significant judgment and critical review of assumptions made about the future.

In this seminar, the speakers will cover challenging aspects of auditing an impairment assessment, including the application of key accounting concepts. They will also explore how to apply professional judgment and skepticism in auditing such a highly judgmental area.
