HKICPA seminar: New HKCO: Impacts on Financial Reporting

The new Hong Kong Companies Ordinance ("HKCO") has imposed various significant changes on the financial reporting framework, which affects the requirements on the financial statements and directors' reports. This seminar will cover the following key financial reporting related issues:

- Overview of financial reporting frameworks
- Impact on directors' reports
- Impact on financial statements
- Criteria for exemption of consolidation

Apart from the above, it will cover the requirements concerning the publication of a company's "non-statutory accounts" under Section 436 of the new HKCO and the relevant guidance issued by the HKICPA (e.g. Accounting Bulletin 6). Finally, the speakers will discuss the different requirements under the new HKCO and HKFRSs in connection with the preparation of consolidated financial statements.
