

# **CPD Seminars – Environmental, Social and Governance ('ESG') Series** (January to February 2016)

Our ESG Series is designed for professionals who are interested in developing their knowledge about the issues relating to sustainability reporting, ESG performance, ESG reporting requirements and the benefits of ESG management. HKEx issued a consultation paper in July 2015 to seek comments on proposed amendments to the ESG Guide in its Listing Rules. On 21 December 2015, it published the consultation conclusions, which require that the upgrade of the general disclosures in the ESG Guide from the level of "recommended" to "comply or explain", as well as the revised recommended disclosures, will be effective for financial years of Hong Kong listed companies commencing on or after 1 January 2016. This requirement drives a need in ESG reporting and poses challenges to many Hong Kong listed companies.

In January and February 2016, the speaker from a Global Reporting Initiative ("GRI") Certified Training Partner will conduct 2 seminars covering the guidelines issued by GRI and HKEx and practical skills in ESG reporting in order to assist participants to work with their companies or business partners to tackle the challenges.
