Leaders are charged with delivering success for their organisations. They do this through formulating and executing strategy. Yet evidence shows that very few organisations are able to execute their strategy effectively. This is due to at least four barriers: (1) vision; (2) people; (3) resource; and (4) management.

Management accounting can play an effective role in strategy execution by helping leaders of organisations to overcome these barriers by collecting, analysing and communicating relevant information at the right time to the right people. This seminar will examine some of the management accounting techniques and tools that have been used successfully by many organisations to achieve strategic success.
