Costing is not simply a case of collecting costs in accounting buckets summating them and churning out a standard accountant's report, nor does it need to be so complex that it becomes meaningless to managers. This fast-paced workshop has a topic range that gives maximum attention to the Big-3 costing systems, processes and techniques of Activity-Based Costing ("ABC"), Standard Costing, and Zero-Based Costing ("ZBC").

The speaker will explain how each of these three systems works, their features and benefits as well as disadvantages and limitations. Examples will be discussed, taken from experienced real-world companies showing how problems were overcome from a practical application of costing techniques.
