In China, the China Insurance Regulatory Commission and other Chinese regulatory organizations have published a series of regulations and guidance over risk management and internal controls for listed companies. In Hong Kong, the directors of listed companies in Hong Kong should conduct a review of the effectiveness of the Group's internal control systems and report to shareholders annually. Thus, building an effective risk management and internal control system has been increasingly important for listed companies in both China and Hong Kong. The objective of this seminar is to describe in general how listed companies can build up an effective internal control system which enables them to facilitate regulatory compliance and beat market expectations.
