# HKICPA seminar: Business and Family Succession

In Hong Kong, many founders of family businesses have reached their age of retirement and their families have to face the difficulties of business and family succession. In the meantime, the succession issues have also offered valuable business opportunities to different stakeholders including professional accountants, lawyers, trustees, private bankers and financial planners etc.

In the past, the founders, their family members and senior management of the family business may tend to focus on the relevant legal and financial issues of succession management. However, in order to protect the interest of the founders' families and businesses in the long run, it is equally important to consider the value, relationship and ethics of family legacy during the planning, implementation and monitoring of the succession process.

In this seminar, the speakers will first talk about the important elements and best practices of succession management as well as cover the concept of family business governance. They will also explain how the Holistic Wealth Family Legacy Five-Dimension Model (including (i) family value consensus, (ii) family relationship sustainability, (iii) family knowledge transformation, (iv) family wealth management and (v) family enterprise succession) can create positive value to the succession management. Real-life case studies will also be shared with the participants in the seminar.
