

Mini Bridge Tournament 2015



With a view to promoting bridge card game to the general membership; providing more opportunities for bridge lovers to participate in tournaments and allowing players of different levels to play together, the Institute's **Bridge Interest Group (BrIG)** has organised four mini bridge tournaments in 2015 to be held on a quarterly basis, in addition to the annual CPA bridge tournament. The fourth tournament of the season has been scheduled for **Saturday**, **5 December 2015** as below:

4th Mini Bridge Tournament

Date Saturday, 5 December 2015

Time 2:00 pm – 7:30 pm

Venue Hong Kong Institute of CPAs, Room M1 - M2,

27/F, Wu Chung House, 213 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong.

Eligible participants HKICPA members only. Priority is given to Bridge Interest Group members.

No. of players: Min. 16 and max. 40 players

Entry fee \$200 per pair / \$100 per individual

About the tournament

- Different ranking point systems are adopted in different tournaments: 1st and 3rd tournament use International Match Point (IMP) while 2nd and 4th tournament use Match Points (MP).
- The same rules and regulations as in the annual CPA Bridge Tournament will be adopted, namely, the 2007 Laws of Duplicate Bridge.
- The decision of the tournament director is regarded as final and no appeal will be entertained.
- Both individual and pair entry are welcome. In the former case, the Institute will arrange another player to form a pair for participation.
- The Institute reserves the right to change the format of the game as and when required.
- The quarterly held mini tournaments are subject to be rescheduled to a later date due to insufficient enrolments or venue unavailability.
- For the purpose of awarding the Bridge Interest Group Trophy, a tournament season means 4 matches held consecutively within a year. The season may be extended up to 2 years when rescheduling of matches is unavoidable.

Awards

A trophy will be awarded to Champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up in each mini tournament.

In addition, a **Bridge Interest Group Trophy** will be awarded at the end of each tournament season to the top three BrIG members who score the top three highest accumulative BrIG points in any one tournament season.

Please refer to the section headed "Bridge Interest Group Trophy" for information about the computation of BrIG points.

No Show penalty

Bridge is a partnership game. We expect every player to turn up at the tournament after confirmation of their registration. However if any player cannot attend the tournament because of whatever reason, he/she should notify the Institute in writing well in advance unless the circumstance is beyond the control of the relevant player. In the notice, he/she should specify if his/her partner wishes to continue and if so, whether he/she will find his/her partner or that he/she will leave the matter to the management.

In the event of last minute no-show without reasonable excuse, the Institute will impose a penalty to the defaulter who will not be allowed to enroll in the *next match* of the Mini Bridge Tournament to discourage such irresponsible behavior.

Bridge Interest Group Trophy

Only members of the Bridge Interest Group (BrIG) are eligible to be awarded the **Bridge Interest Group Trophy**. They must have participated three out of four mini tournaments in any one tournament season. Trophies will be awarded to the top three players who have obtained the highest accumulative BrIG points.

1. The points are awarded as per the following table:

	BrIG point
Ranking in each	awarded to each
mini tournament	player
1st	20
2nd	16
3rd	14
4th	12
5th	6
6th	5
7th	4
8th	3
9th	2
10th	1

- 2. When there is a tie on the ranking, each player will be awarded equal share of the relevant BrIG points. For example, when two pairs tie in the 3rd place in a mini tournament, each player of the relevant pairs will be awarded 13 BrIG points (i.e, (14 + 12)/2). All BrIG points will be rounded to one decimal place. The next highest point pair will then rank the 5th, not the 4th as the two pairs tied will deem to have taken the 3rd and the 4th rank each scores the average of the total relevant points.
- 3. The points listed in the above table are awarded in accordance with the actual number of players.
- 4. Any BrIG member who has participated in all four matches in a tournament season will be given an additional 4 BrIG points to his/her accumulative points.
- 5. All players are free to form their own partnership. However, an additional 3 BrIG points will be awarded to any BrIG member who plays with a partner paired up by the Institute. The added points are intended to recognize the added challenge of playing with a new partner.
- 6. Each champion player has to pair up a different partner in the immediate next match within the same tournament season.
- 7. No BrIG points will be carried forward to the next tournament season. The fourth match of each season concludes the tournament season. Points obtained in any mini tournaments may be used for reference when a handicap system is introduced in the future.

To enrol for the 4th Mini Bridge Tournament, please return the completed entry form together with payment to the Institute on or before 18 November 2015.

- 2. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
- 3. The closing date for enrolment is 18 November 2015. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late applications as it sees fit
- 4. Application by fax will ONLY be accepted when payment is made by credit card. Cash is strictly NOT accepted.
