## About the Instructors

**Ms. Lily Cheng** with a solid training in modern dance and tango has become a full time tango teacher since 2011. Her passion in tango is fully manifested in her frequent trips to Buenos Aires to hone her skill in this passionate Latin dance. Her choreography debut “Tied” won the silver award (modern dance) of the Hong Kong Open Dance Competition in 2000.

**Mr. Raymond Chu** has begun his Tango journey since 2003. His teachers include world famous Tango professionals from all over the world. He spent a considerable time in Buenos Aires to learn Tango. He combines the traditional elegant Tango style and the nuevo Tango style in his dancing.

Raymond started performing Tango in 2005 and has since then demonstrated and performed Tango on many occasions. He has been invited by the largest Tango Club, Tangotang, as a guest teacher for their workshops.

**Lily and Raymond** have started to teach Tango dancing together since 2006. They are the only Chinese dancers who had won the champions of the Asian Championship (salon tango category) in Japan. They represented Asia to participate in the World Championship 2011 in Buenos Aires and made their way to the top 4 in the semi-final among over 400 professional dancers from all over the world.
