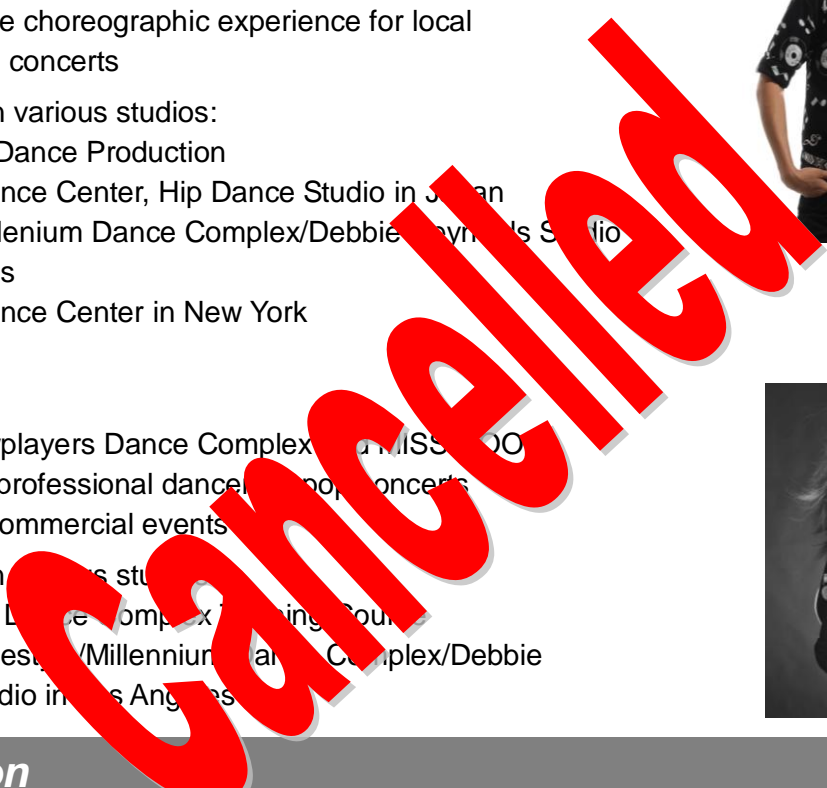

3. The closing date for enrolment is 18 May 2015. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late applications as it sees fit.
