Course Contents:

1. Singing techniques and the vocal process such as inhalation, phonation, resonance and diction (Pieces selected from Chinese and Western songs and musicals, such as "Santa Lucia", "Under the Silver moon", etc.).
2. Increase awareness of one's vocal range and sound quality, and how to select a song that's suitable for one's ability (each student will receive a record).
3. Music appreciation of both Chinese and Western Vocal works.
4. Music theory and sight reading skills,

In 1988, Ms. Ng went to Europe to further her training and obtained Diplome Superieur conferred by Conservatoire Europeen De Musique De Paris with distinction. Sandra was the apprentice of Lola Young (楊羅娜) and Lee Bing (李冰). She was also the apprentice of Irma Kolassi while attending the master classes given by Irma. She is active in the performing arena. This year, the Polish Chopin Culture Exchange Foundation invited Ms. Ng to perform in Poland.

Lincoln Hui graduated from Pennsylvania State University in United States and is pupil of Lynn Drafall and Christopher Kiver. He was active as a conductor and invited to instruct the Pennsylvania State Japanese Acappella Club. He was the singing accompaniment for the Oriana Singers and University Choir groups.
