It is time of the year for new recruitment for the 2018 season. Regular weekly practice will begin on Sunday, **25 February (9:00 to 11:30 am) in Sai Kung until end of race season in October/November**. Additional training may be scheduled nearer the time of races at different locations.

Subject to the strategic plans of the organising committee in the best interest of DBIG's development, new recruits will have the opportunity to participate in competitions with experienced paddlers. Team selection, conducted by the convenor and the coach will, among other things, base on paddlers' performance, commitment, trainings (other than DBIG's) and team spirit.

Members with no paddling experience are welcome to join as there will be two foundation training sessions on *4 and 11 March* especially for them.

If you are interested to join this seasonal sport, <u>enrol online</u> by **20 February 2018**. Current paddlers are also required to sign up for the 2018 season. The enrolment fee (\$360) covers training, race registration and other ancillary costs.
