

Listings of PRC businesses in Hong Kong

About the topic

In the past, the regulatory requirements of PRC authorities had made listings of PRC businesses in Hong Kong very difficult. We see that such hurdles have been relaxed in recent years, which have made listings of PRC businesses in Hong Kong easier. The PRC enterprises now account for a significant portion of the proceeds raised from the initial public offerings ("IPOs") and listings on the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong.

At this seminar, Mr. Raymond Cheung, Partner and Head of Corporate and Commercial Department, ONC Lawyers, will talk about common issues PRC businesses may experience when they prepare for their listings in Hong Kong, including:

- whether the PRC business should be listed as a "red chip" or an "H-share"?
- what are the common reorganisation plans adopted by PRC enterprises?
- the feasibility of listing by way of variable interest entity ("VIE") structures?
