# Fraud Risk Indicators in China

## About the topic

Investing in emerging markets, such as China, can offer significant rewards, but it also carries some additional risk, including the risk of financial statement manipulation. Investors need to ensure that sufficient and extensive due diligence is carried out prior to making their investment decisions in order to reduce the chances of investments in Chinese companies turning sour.

In this seminar, the speaker will talk about being alert to situations of possible fraud, including how to identify indicators of fraud risk, in the context of actual cases.
