Ms. Sou Chiam is a mediator and barrister-at-law with extensive legal, policy and management experience. She was Senior Legal Counsel and Head of the Human Rights Policy Unit in the New Zealand Human Rights Commission. She was part of senior management in the financial services industry. She was a law lecturer at the Chinese University of Hong Kong and taught Administrative Law and Mediation. She was formerly Senior Crown Counsel in the Commercial Crimes Unit at the Hong Kong Attorney General's Chambers and prosecuted corruption and commercial crime cases. She represented the Hong Kong government at the Privy Council. Most recently she was the Secretary to the Mediation Task Force chaired by the Secretary for Justice and worked on the enactment of the Mediation Ordinance for Hong Kong.
