ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The global retail payments market has been developing rapidly. In Hong Kong, technological advancements and increasing acceptance of new technologies by the public have led to the emergence of new forms of retail payment products and services in recent years.

To ensure the safety and soundness of these payment facilities and systems, the government has introduced the <u>Clearing and Settlement Systems (Amendment) Bill 2015</u> to provide for a new regulatory framework for stored value facilities (SVF) and retail payment systems (RPS).

The new regulatory framework comprises a licensing regime for SVF, a designation regime for RPS and relevant supervisory and enforcement powers of the HKMA to implement the relevant regulatory requirements. The Bill was introduced into the Legislative Council on 4 February 2015 and is currently being scrutinized.

At the seminar, Mr. Shu-Pui LI, Head of Financial Infrastructure Development Division of the HKMA, will cover the latest development of the Bill and introduce the new framework for SVF and RPS.

ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Mr. Shu-Pui LI is currently the Head of Financial Infrastructure Development Division of the HKMA. His major responsibilities include development and promotion of the financial infrastructure in Hong Kong; and coordination with overseas central banks and service providers to facilitate cross-border cooperation in financial infrastructure development. He has over 20 years of experience in auditing and management consultancy services, technology risk management, banking supervision and financial infrastructure development.

Prior to joining the HKMA, Mr. Li was the Head of Asia Technology Risk Management of Chase Manhattan Bank and the Regional Information Risk Management Officer of JPMorgan Chase in Asia. His major responsibilities included the formulation and execution of the Bank's technology/information risk management programme, performance of risk assessment of Internet and E-commerce projects, review and enforcement of the Bank's information technology control policy and standards, development and testing of the business continuity plans, and implementation of information security awareness programmes.

Mr. Li is a Chartered Accountant (FCA) of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England & Wales, a Chartered Information System Engineer (CEng), a Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA) and a member of the British Computer Society.

He has also obtained a master's degree in Research of Computer Graphics and a bachelor's (1st Class Hons) degree in Computing Science at the University of Manchester.
