ABOUT THE SEMINAR

An ETF, or exchange traded fund, is a marketable security that tracks an index, a commodity, bonds, or a basket of assets like an index fund. Unlike mutual funds, an ETF trades like a common stock on a stock exchange. In 2008 the US Securities and Exchange Commission began to authorize the creation of actively managed ETFs. US ETF assets went above \$2 trillion in December 2014.

In Hong Kong, ETFs are traded on the securities market of Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited ("HKEx"). The average daily turnover of HKEx's ETF market was HK\$8.22 billion in March 2015, up 210% from the same period last year.

At the seminar, Mr. Ray Chan and Mr. David Chai from SSGA Asia will give the latest update on ETFs including the global development and trends, portfolio implementation of using ETFs and insights into evaluating ETFs. They will also take questions from the floor.

Mr. Ray Chan is currently the Vice President and Head of ETF Business Development, Asia ex-Japan at State Street Global Advisors Asia Limited ("SSGA Asia").

Mr. Chan has an extensive background in the asset management industry and specializes in investment advisory for institutional investors and wealth managers across asset classes. Currently, he oversees the SPDR ETFs team for Asia ex-Japan which focuses on providing specialist consultation and services to institutional clients and wealth management distributors on the use and trading execution of ETFs in investment portfolios.

Prior to joining SSGA Asia, Mr. Chan held various senior positions working with the leading global asset managers including Schroders, Legg Mason, and Capital Group. He obtained his business administration degree from the University of Hawaii, USA.

Mr. David Chai is the Managing Director of State Street Global Advisors ("SSGA") and Head of Global Structured Products at SSGA Asia, responsible for overseeing the indexing investment including ETFs in the region of Asia ex-Japan.

Mr. Chai joined SSGA, Australia, Limited in May 2001 as a Portfolio Manager in the Global Structured Products Group. In 2006, he was relocated to Hong Kong to take up the existing position.

Mr. Chai was awarded a First Class Honors degree in Science and a Master of Science degree in Mathematical Statistics from Monash University, Victoria.
