ABOUT THE SEMINAR

To enhance the protection afforded to professional investors who are not institutional investors, the Securities and Futures Commission ("SFC") commenced a comprehensive review of the existing Professional Investor Regime (the "Regime") in late 2011. It issued a consultation paper on the proposed amendments to the Regime in May 2013 and the consultation conclusions in September 2014. The amendments relating to the Regime will become effective in March 2016.

At the seminar, Ms. Mok will give an overview of the existing Regime under the law and the Code of Conduct for Persons Licensed by or Registered with the SFC, as well as the key features of the revised Regime.
