#### ABOUT THE SEMINAR

It is a widely-held belief that ethnic Chinese family businesses are short-lived and subject to a "curse" which states that "wealth does not pass beyond three generations" (富不過三代). What is succession? Is it the succession within the family? Or is it succession within the family business?

At this seminar, Dr. Roger King, an Adjunct Professor of Finance, HKUST, will share the unique characteristics of Chinese family businesses and examine the causes of this early demise. Using a case-based study, Dr. King will analyze seven flourishing Chinese family-controlled businesses to determine how they survived and endured beyond 100 years. The results of case study will be shared from the perspective of three underlying factors including "trans-generational entrepreneurship", "harmonization of Western and Chinese values" and "pruning of ownership".

#### **ABOUT THE SPEAKER**

**Dr. Roger King** is an Adjunct Professor of Finance and the Founding Director of Tanoto Center for Asian Family Business and Entrepreneurship Studies and Thompson Center for Business Case Studies at the HKUST.

Dr. King was a former US Naval Officer, Member of Technical Staff of Bell Telephone Laboratories (USA), the Chief Operating Officer of Orient Overseas (Holdings) Limited, the Chairman and founder of ODS System-Pro Computers Limited, the Chairman of Euro-Asia Shipyard Limited and Pacific Coffee Limited, the President and Chief Executive Officer of Sa Sa International Holdings Limited, the Board Director of Arrow Electronics Corporation and Sincere Watch (Hong Kong) Limited, the President of Harvard Business School Association of Hong Kong, the Chairman of the Association of Honorary Consuls in Hong Kong and Macau, the Standing Committee Member of the Zhejiang Province People's Political Consultative Conference, and the Council Member of the Hong Kong Baptist University and HKUST.

Currently, Dr. King is a Supervisory Board member of TNT Express, an Non-Executive Director of Overseas Orient International, a Honorary Consul for the Republic of Latvia in HKSAR, a Member of the Editorial Board of Journal of Family Business Strategy, the 2011 recipient of the HKUST Honorary Fellow, a member of Eta Kappa Nu and Beta Gamma Sigma, honorary society for electric engineers and business scholars, respectively.

Dr. King is a graduate of the University of Michigan with a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering; New York University with a Master of Science in Electrical Engineering; Harvard Business School completing the Advanced Management Program; and HKUST with a PhD (Finance).
