#### ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The "One country, two systems" concept is unprecedented under which the Basic Law ensures that Hong Kong retains its own systems, including legal system and law enforcement agencies, etc. for fifty years after the return of sovereignty in 1997. Over the past 18 years, Mainland and Hong Kong have established close economic and social ties. The Hong Kong Police Force and other law enforcement agencies in Hong Kong, which are under the Common Law system, have been working closely with relevant Mainland authorities in face of the challenges arising from this unique circumstance.

At the seminar, Mr. Homer Lam of the Commercial Crime Bureau will give an overview of the legal systems in the Mainland and Hong Kong from the commercial crime perspective, as well as the existing legal and administrative arrangement between the Mainland and Hong Kong law enforcement authorities on crime investigation.
