Basic principles and insights on Fair value measurements

The measurement of fair value under HKFRS may not be an easy task as often times it requires judgment from the management team. HKFRS 13 is a standard which defines fair value and provides guidance, under a principles-based framework, on how to measure fair value under HKFRS where entities are permitted or required to measure or disclose the fair value of assets, liabilities, or equity instruments. This seminar aims to outline the basic principles of HKFRS 13 and provide some insights on measurement of fair value from a valuer's perspective.
