

## Tips for Answering Multiple Choice Questions

- 1. First and foremost, get well prepared for the examination and study the learning materials of the module.
- 2. Get familiar with the MCQ question types in the examination. Read the <u>sample</u> <u>questions</u> on the HKICPA website.
- Exercise good time management in tackling the questions. The examination lasts for 105 minutes, with 1-mark and 2-mark MCQs totaling 60 marks. Allocate approximately 1.75 minutes and 3.5 minutes for answering the 1-mark and 2-mark questions respectively.
- 4. Answer all questions. Marks are not deducted for incorrect answers.
- 5. Answer questions in order. If a question requires a longer thinking time, take an educated guess and come back to it after other questions are answered.
- 6. Read the questions carefully to understand the question requirements.
- 7. Identify negative phrases in the question stem, for example "no", "not", "false", or "does not describe" to avoid misunderstandings.
- 8. Identify qualifiers which express specific circumstances or conditions.
  - Indications of time: before, after, while, always, never
  - Superlatives: most, least, most common, fastest, the best, the only
  - Conditionals: if, unless, assuming
- 9. Try answering the questions in your own words before reading the answer options.
- 10. Eliminate answer options which appear to be least suitable.
- 11. Choose answer option that fully addresses the question requirement.
- 12. Avoid judging the correctness of answer options merely by their length.
- 13. Avoid excessive pondering over the answer options. The examination serves to objectively assess candidates' knowledge and skills. Questions are not designed to trick candidates on purpose.
