

Insolvency Preparatory I (Webinar)

About the course

The Institute's Insolvency Preparatory I (webinars) course focuses on broad knowledge and understanding of the basic principles of insolvency administration, with particular emphasis on the practical issues related to these areas.

1. **What is Insolvency?**
2. **Liquidations, Bankruptcy, and IVAs**
3. **Investigation and Asset Realisation**
4. **Overview of Administrations and Priorities of Creditors**
5. **Receivership, Trading and Selling a Business, and Provisional Supervision**

The course will run through five Saturdays over webinars commencing on **15 November 2025**. Experienced specialists in field of insolvency will share with participants their expertise in different subject areas. The sequence of topic may vary from the tentative plan.
