



CPA Graded Bowling Competition

Grading Rules

$$\text{Graded Average (GA)} = \frac{\text{Total Pin Falls for all contestants}}{\text{Total Games played by all contestants}}$$

For example:

$$\text{Graded Average (GA)} = \frac{14,000 \text{ pin}}{100 \text{ games}} = 140$$

- (i) GA is the minimum average of Grade B
- (ii) GA + 20 is the minimum average of Grade A
- (iii) Any scoring below GA will be graded as Grade C

In the above example, contestants scoring 160 or above will be competing within the Grade A; contestants scoring 140-159.99 will be competing within Grade B; and contestants scoring 139.99 or below will be competing within Grade C.

Same Score:

In the event of tie, the score of the last game played will be used to determine the final winner.
