Benefit


→ Participants may have opportunities being invited to join dragon boat team as nominated by the coach and the organizing committee of DBIG.

- 3. Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 3 or above / Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted 2 hours prior to the commencement of the training. Members will be notified through the WhatsApp group.
