Hirsch Vineyards

Peter Michael, Marcassin, Kistler: it is not by chance if some of the most acclaimed US Pinot Noirs all come from Sonoma Coast. Though famous today, this cool & humid sub-region north of the main viticultural area of Sonoma was completely unknown back in the early 1980s when David Hirsch planted his first vineyard. 30 years later, he is revered as a pioneer.

The cool (cold) climate of the region combined with the amazing geologic puzzle created by the San Andreas Fault give birth to elegant and graceful Pinot Noirs, far from the richer fruit-driven examples that put Sonoma on the map. Hirsch is one of the leading light of this trend which has won the recognition of the most demanding Pinot critics of all: Allen Meadows.

Hacienda Monasterio

Hacienda Monasterio is owned by Carlos del Rio whose family has been in the sherry business for decades. Being fortunate enough to own some prime, south-facing parcels on the right side of the river, Carlos hired Peter "Pingus" Sisseck, the owner and winemaker of the famed Ribera estate to take over the winemaking in 1995. Peter has helped turn this old estate into a Ribera powerhouse with wines.

The estate is located on a southern hillside, covering 160 Hectares, 78 of which are planted with vines. The vineyards located on a north-south-facing slope, which is a strategic place for the proper growth and maturing of the grapes. The heterogeneous composition of the soils allows sub-dividing the estate in plots, all of them with the same common denominator: a high concentration of limestone which gives the wines subtlety and elegance.
