

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Champagne R. Pouillon

(Champagne, France)
Practicing biodynamic





The Pouillon family has been growing grapes in the region for over a century in Aÿ, Mareuil-sur-Aÿ and Avenay Val d'Or in the Grande Vallée, Epernay and just to the north in the Montagne de Reims. The majority of the plantings are to pinot noir (3ha), followed by chardonnay (2ha) and pinot meunier (1ha). In 2003, he began the work of conversion to organic viticulture and today he incorporates biodynamic principles into his work including compost management, spraying herbal tea. Fruit is harvested by hand. The wines are aged in a combination of stainless steel and older oak demi-muids and barriques. All of the wines undergo full malolactic fermention. There is also a stainless-steel "solera" with wines dating back to the late 90's. The results are electric, terroir driven wines with high-toned aromatics, fresh acidity, and incredible length. These are wines that are light on their feet yet possess depth and intensity that continually unfold with each sip.

Enrico Serafino (Piedmont, Italy)

Jondata nel 1878 ENRICO SERAFINO UN

The Enrico Serafino winery began wine making in 1878 in Canale d'Alba, in the heart of Roero. At the end of the 18th century it was one of the first cellars to export wine to foreign countries, even outside Europe. At the end of the '80s the cellar was acquired by Barbero 1891 that restored and modernized the whole structure, improving production. Since 2004 Enrico Serafino has been a part of Gruppo Campari. Obtained from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes grown in Piedmont's unique Alta Langa region. This sparkling wine spends 36 months maturing on the lees. The wine is straw yellow. Subtly harmonious bouquet of honey, summer flowers and yeasty. Tiny lingering bubbles and dry, savoury palate. Drink at 6-8 degrees. A great wine for every occasion! Domaine Bott Geyl

(Alsace, France)
COMING SOON end 2015



A lot of very good wines are made in Beblenheim, not least from the Grands Crus Sonnenglanz and Schoenenbourg, but the only bright star is Bott-Geyl. But what a star! Bott-Geyl was formed in 1953 and since 1993 it is led by Jean-Christophe Bott and Valerie Bott. During the strong influence of his mentor Leonard Humbrecht the production was changed to organic and biodynamic principles in the early 2000s. But today the wines are not just good, they exhibit great personality, unusual depth of flavour and astonishing minerality. Bott-Geyl is a striking example of how progressiveness and tradition come together in today's Alsace. Furthermore, prices are still at a very reasonable level. So there is no excuse for not getting to know this genuine family domain.

Delicate bubbles, fresh and complex. Great sparkling! Pinot Noir and Chardonnay 5q/L,

Chateau Toutigeac

(Bordeaux, France)



Who knows when Bordeaux will have another vintage like 2010? Canny claret lovers will stock up gems like Château Toutigeac while the going is good. Set in the heart of the Entre Deux Mers and dating from the 12th century, Toutigeac has been in the same family for the past five generations. Since 1973 it has accumulated more than 50 medals from competitions in Paris, Bordeaux and London's International Wine Challenge. Oriane Mazeau now has the honour of trying to extend that impressive track record. Cabernet Franc dominates her 2009, providing a lovely blackcurrant and bell pepper freshness to the liquorice notes so typical of the region. Decant and serve this rich, supple claret with grilled red meats, casseroles or a cheese board.

White wine:

- Chateau Toutigeac "X" 2012

A pleasant golden wine with aromas of citrus fruits, wood, brioche and grilled almond.

Red wine:

- Chateau Toutigeac "O" 2010

Domaine Samuel Billaud

(Bourgogne, France)

Practicing organic



Established in 1815, the Billaud family is one of the oldest families of wine growers in Chablis. Samuel Billaud is now the 6th generation to inherit the Chablis sprit. His father André, his grandfather Jean and his great grandfather Jules handed down to him their passion and _savoir faire_ in this marvellous trade. In June 2010, after spending 20 years growing and making wine at the family domain (Domaine Billaud-Simon in Chablis), Samuel Billaud established his own vinification and sales house. Using small-volume stainless steel tanks and 450 - 600 liter casks, he takes great care to preserve the unique features of Chablis in order to obtain pure and crystalline wines. Last summer, the Domaine Billaud-Simon has been sold to the family Faiveley who has bought the 2/3 of Billaud-Simon, except the part of vineyard: Samuel Billaud

Domaine Latour-Giraud

(Bourgogne, France)

Practicing organic



Charles and Maxime, the 2 grandfathers Giraud and Latour, gave their names to Domaine Latour-Giraud. Jean-Pierre is known as one of Meursault's best winemakers. The estate underwent a dramatic revival when he took over in the 1990s. His styles are intense and concentrated, stylish and powerful, layered and balanced. The Latour-Giraud Meursault combine lemon-pear-quince-citrus fruits with the characteristic mineral qualities of the soil and layers of sweet vanilla oak and toast. Jean-Pierre ferments only free-run juice with wild, natural yeasts. The wines are kept on their lees (40-70% new barrels) as long as possible. They are none filtered, and bottled by hand. Domaine Clos Salomon

(Bourgogne, France) COMING SOON end 2015



A Domaine since the 1300s, its wines were once a direct supplier of the Pope in Avignon. Burgundy historian Claude Courtepee called it the "Volnay of the Chalonnais" and the "best of the province" over two hundred years ago. It has been in the hands of the current owner, the du Gardin family, for over three hundred years. Today, it is run by the hilarious, down to earth, and dynamic young duo of Ludovic du Gardin and Fabrice Perrotto, and these lads are starting to turn some heads. Ludo and Fabrice continue to push quality to a level that is a reflection of their devotion, knowledge, and care for this monopole 1er cru. Their vineyard work is all organic; they plow by horse. And it all hits home, in the glass, in undeniable deliciousness.

White wine:

- Montagny 1er Cru Le Clou 2014

Aged in 20% new wood, this wine has a great balance of weight and cut, richness with mineral tension. The only producers in blanc 1er at this site.

- Givry 1er Cru Clos Salomon monopole 2014

Straw Ripe Pinot with Kirsch, cherry, fennel notes. Medium rusticity and gentle balance of acidity. What a great wine! Highest points ever rated for Givry. Eat with cold cuts, truffle, mushrooms, pigeon,.. Allen Meadows 92/100

Domaine Lupin

(Haut-Savoie, France)

Practicing organic



Bruno Lupin is a winemaker with extensive experience. Before moving back to his hometown to establish his own estate, he ran the cellar at La Cave de Genève in Switzerland for many years. The Lupin estate consists of five hectares of vines in Frangy on a hillside called Les Aricoques. Bruno considers this location the best in the region due to the full southern exposure and the relatively low altitude that protects the vineyards from the cold northern winds. The soils are molasses, a crumbly calcareous soil resulting from old mountain erosion. Most of the vines are about 25 years old but there is a single parcel of individually staked vines that are over 60 years old. This site is the source of his old vines wine: "Cuvée du Pépé". The wines are fermented with indigenous yeasts and are never de-acidified (although it is a common practice in the area). Bruno works his vineyards organically most of the time, only resorting to chemicals when absolutely necessary to preserve the health of his plants.

White wine:

- Roussette de Savoie Traditionelle 2014

Bright, white fruit (apricot, peach, pear) and blossoms on the nose, with crushed oyster shell. Striking minerals, mouth-filling quality and long finish. Seafood

Lots of white flowers, pear, and a bready note in the background. Great structure, rich mouth feel, and a super long finish.

Collina Serragrilli

(Piedmont, Italy)

Practicing organic

Collina SERRAGRILLI

Since the end of the 19th century the land of Collina Serragrilli has been farmed by four generations of the same family. From the days when grapes were sold in vats, and wine in bulk in barrels loaded onto ox-drawn carts, the business has been passed down from father to son. Today it is run with integrity and enterprise by the latest generation of the Lequio family with the help of their husbands and in-laws, whose background is also in wine. Grandfather and great-grandfather were local own growers who manage the vineyards of the highest quality, and the winery remains at the forefront of winegrowing in the area.

White wine:

- Roero Arneis 2013 DOCG

A light, straw yellow wine with hints of exotic fruits. Subtle acidity, firm structure and great balanced finish.

Moscato d'Asti 2013 DOCG (semi-sweet sparkling)

HK\$ 130/bottle

Natural fermentation 5,5% alcohol with natural CO2. Exotic, citrusy, lychee and juicy finish. Well structured. Drink young and well chilled.

Red wine:

- Amerai IGT 2012 Super Piedmont

Four stunning grapes, Dolcetto, Freisa, Pinot Noir and Barbera. Red cherry and vanilla concentration. Soft tannins, hint of almonds.

-Grillorosso 2009 DOC Super Piedmont

HK\$ 140/bottle

A garnet red wine with cherry, vanilla and roasted hazelnuts aromas. This wine is rich and full-bodied with a long, complex finish.

- Barbera d'Alba "Grillaia" 2010 DOC

HK\$ 180/bottle

Ruby red color wine. Rich, warm and densy. Elegancy of jam, plum. Juicy tannins and a long finish.

- Barolo "La Tur" 2010 DOCG

HK\$ 360/bottle

The Grand Cru from La Morra. Deep red, purple wine. High complexity of red fruits, spices and minerals. A long, mouthful finish.

- Barbaresco 2010 DOCG

HK\$ 390/bottle

100% Nebbiolo. Garnet red wine, spicy nose and red fruits. Acidity is luscious & tannins are profound.



I Giusti e Zanza

(Tuscany, Italy)
Practicing organic



The small farm of Mr. Giusti and Mr. Zanza lies in the northwest of Toscana, not far from historic Pisa. The vineyards are situated on gentle sunny slopes with ample sea breezes. The soil is an ideal mix of sandy gravel and limestone clay, with excellent drainage. The area is regarded similar to Bordeaux and so it has become known as a premier spot for Bordeaux style wine. I Giusti e Zanza has been working toward organic certification for several years. The birth of this vineyard came from the passion of these two men and their passion for wine is evident in every bottle.

White wine:

- Nemorino white IGT 2013

HK\$ 145/bottle

Straw yellow color, elegant and exotic sensations. Notes of acacia and pineapple and a twist of minerals. Long finish.

Red wine:

- Nemorino red IGT 2013

HK\$ 145/bottle

Deep violet red color, hints of blackcurrant, sugar snaps and violet flowers. Great balance of fruit and acidity in the mouth.

- Belcore Super Tuscan IGT 2013

HK\$ 235/bottle

Dark cherry red, fruity nose of plum, blackberries. Medium bodied and great acidity. A wine to drink now.

- Perbruno Super Tuscan IGT 2013

HK\$ 295/bottle

Dark cherry red with violet tears, round intense fruity nose of plum, black currant and pepper. Medium bodied and great acidity in overall.

- Dulcamara Super Tuscan IGT 2012

HK\$ 450/bottle

Deep, dark intense cherry red with red tears. Complex nose of blackcurrant, plums, spices, peppers and violet. Explosive fruit and acidity in the mouth and superb long finish. 93/100 wine



Dr. Burklin Wolf (Pfalz, Germany)



The Dr. Bürklin-Wolf Estate is the largest family owned winery in the heart of the. The vineyards are located in Wachenheim, Forst, Deidesheim and Ruppertsberg including the monopol sites "Wachenheimer Rechbächel" and "Gaisböhl" in Ruppertsberg. Her model is that of Burgundy, with 4 tiers of quality: basic "estate" wine, named "village" cuvées, premier crus (which she calls "P.C.") and grand crus ("G.C."). After historical and geological research, she discovered that her own classification matched exactly the Royal Bavarian Vineyard Classification of 1828. With the advantageous, mild climate of the Pfalz, the excellent soils of the Mittelhaardt, with their varying structures of basalt, sandstone and limestone, have always brought wines of the highest quality, although only the harmony between, terroir, vine and man brings truly great wines. This philosophy has motivated Bettina to undertake a total conversion to Biodynamic viticulture, completed in 2005, and Burklin-Wolf has thus become the first German member of the prestigious Biodyvin group.

-Riesling Trocken 2013

Dry, juicy, peach and pine apple aromas with a twist of lime

-Riesling Wachenheimer trocken 2013

Dry, minerals, juicy, limey and white fruits aromas, great finesse on the finish (17/20 Jancis Robinson)

Red wine:

- Villa Burklin Cuvee Rot 2013

Red cherry color, fruity with strawberry aromas, flowers, soft tannins and a great gentle finish
