### About the seminar

#### Topic to be addressed:

As reliance on information technology and the internet has increased, we are seeing growing concerns about cyber security and resilience. Technology trends, such as cloud computing and mobile technology, are creating new challenges for traditional approaches to information security. Media reports, industry surveys and anecdotal evidence all suggest a growth in possible sources of threat and volumes of security breaches. Governments are also showing more interest in the area, as they try to manage risks around the critical national infrastructure and build trust in the digital economy more broadly. But is there really anything new about 'cyber'? What should business priorities be? And how do security concerns relate to wider discussions on privacy and intellectual property in a digital world? The seminar will draw on ICAEW's publications *Audit Insights: Cyber Security* and *Building Trust in the Digital Age*.
