ABOUT THE FORUM

The HKICPA Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (the Code) was revised to maintain convergence with the revised Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants issued by the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants in July 2009. The revised Code clarifies ethical requirements for all professional accountants and strengthens the independence requirements that apply to auditors. The Code was issued in June 2010 and has been effective from 1 January 2011.

The Institute has set up a Special Task Force on Adoption of Revised Code of Ethics by Small and Medium Practitioners to look into implementation issues faced by Small and Medium Practitioners (SMPs).

The objective of the forum is to understand more about the experiences of SMPs when implementing the Code, particularly in relation to provision of taxation, company secretarial and accounting services. A better understanding of such practical issues will enable the Institute to consider how it can provide additional support to SMPs to facilitate their compliance with the Code.
