Highlights The Institute is seeking comments on the IASB Discussion Paper on

Preliminary Views on Financial Statement Presentation, which will have significant impact on preparers and users of financial statements if the

proposed amendments are adopted.

The Discussion Paper introduces cohesiveness and disaggregation as the two main objectives for financial statement presentation. Cohesiveness would ensure that a reader of financial statements can follow the flow of information through the different statements of an entity; disaggregation would ensure that items that respond differently to economic events are shown separately. To achieve these main objectives the IASB and the US Financial Accounting Standards Board have developed a principle-based format that is presented in the Discussion Paper.
