ABOUT THE SEMINAR

On 9 July 2009, the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB), having completed its normal due process of exposure and consultation, issued its final standard on International Financial Reporting Standard for Small and Medium-sized Entities (IFRS for SMEs) with significant simplifications and modifications to its Exposure Draft released in 2007.

Council is of a view that the IFRS for SMEs should be adopted in Hong Kong with certain modifications incorporated to suit Hong Kong circumstances, in the form of Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard for Private Entities (HKFRS for Private Entities), as a reporting option for private companies which have no public accountability. The objective is to ease the reporting burden of eligible companies by relieving them of the requirement to apply full HKFRSs. The scope and applicability of the existing Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards and SME-FRF&FRS should remain.

Council intends to issue the HKFRS for Private Entities on 30 April 2010 to be effective immediately upon release subject only to unforeseen issues identified during the commentary period on the Statement of Intent ending on 31 March 2010. Under the proposal, eligible entities are permitted to use HKFRS for Private Entities to prepare financial statements for prior period(s) where the relevant financial statements have not been finalised and approved.

The HKICPA's Statement of Intent on the matter, the pronouncement of the proposed HKFRS for Private Entities and other technical resources can be downloaded at the HKFRS for Private Entities Information Centre at the HKICPA website.

The speakers will provide an overview on the key differences between the HKFRS for Private Entities and the full HKFRS at the session. This is a good opportunity for the members and other stakeholders to understand the main features of the proposed standard.
