The International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants (IESBA) issued its exposure draft on Responding to a Suspected Illegal Act (ED) on 22 August 2012.

The ED proposes new requirements to both professional accountants in public practice and in business, addressing a professional accountant's

responsibilities regarding the disclosure of suspected illegal acts committed by a

client or employer to an appropriate authority.

The Institute's Ethics Committee has formed a topical working group to work on the ED. This lunch forum is intended to outreach and solicit views from members on this topic, which maybe controversial and important.
