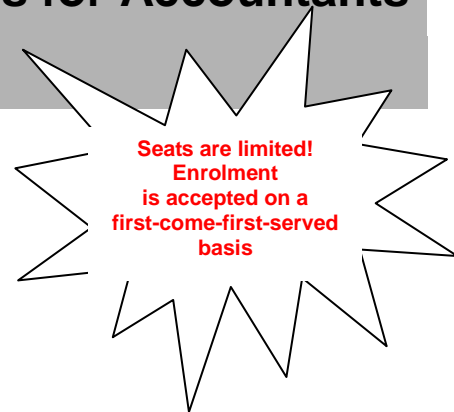


HKICPA/ICAEW Joint Seminar on Ethics for Accountants

Highlights	<p>An accounting professional is expected to always behave ethically and has a responsibility to act in the public interest. Certainly, ethical behaviour is fundamental to both organisational and personal risk management and long-term performance. Yet, in today's challenging economic times, both organisations and individuals can come under pressure to behave unethically for the short-term benefit of either self or others.</p> <p>How can we use IESBA's conceptual framework approach to deal with the pressure to behave unethically? In practical terms, what does integrity mean, both as a concept and in practice? What are the questions to ask to determine the role of integrity in an organisation, and how do we assess and instill this role? How can we determine the public interest?</p> <p>Elizabeth Higgs will present the topic based on the IESBA Code of Ethics, the ICAEW thought leadership reports "Real Integrity", "Acting in the Public Interest". Albert Au will provide his insights on IESBA Code based on his involvement in Ethics Task Force of IFAC SMP Committee.</p>
