2832. <u>Minutes of the 369th Meeting</u>

The Committee approved and the Chairman signed the minutes of the 369^{th} meeting.

2833. Work Plan Status Report and Update from Working Groups

The Committee considered the report and noted progress of various projects.

2834. Experience in the performance of assurance engagements over emerging forms of external reporting ("EER") in Hong Kong and/or Mainland China

It was reported that Mr. Chris Joy, Executive Director of HKICPA, would attend a roundtable discussion held by IAASB in November to discuss the future of assurance over EER. The Committee was requested to provide their experiences, challenges and comments on EER assurance work in Hong Kong and/or Mainland for the purposes of the roundtable discussion.

2835. <u>Exposure draft of PN 850 (Revised), Reporting on Flag Days and</u> <u>General Charitable Fund-raising Activities Covered by Public</u> <u>Subscription Permits issued by the Social Welfare Department</u>

It was reported that the Social Welfare Department ("SWD") had revised its Public Subscription Permit Application Form (including the Permit Conditions section) which is effective for application of permit for charitable fund-raising activities on or after 1 August 2018. The Flag Days Application Form was also revised and will be effective for application in 2019-2020.

PN 850 (Revised) was updated as a result of the revised permit conditions of charitable fund-raising activities and flag days. The Committee had some drafting comments. SSD would follow up the comments received during the meeting and circulate a revised draft for the Committee's approval in due course.

2836. Update on post implementation research project on revised auditor's reports

SSD reported that the desktop review of selected auditor's reports had been completed. The Committee considered the preliminary findings and provided comments for SSD's consideration.

SSD reported that the second phase of the project, qualitative review of selected key audit matters by a panel of HKICPA technical staff and investor group representatives, was in progress. SSD would update the Committee with the findings in due course.

The proposed publication of the research results is expected to be made available before the next reporting season.

2838. Issues related to bank confirmation requests

In July 2018, SSD received a letter from a company which encountered a bank refusing to issue an audit confirmation as the company was no longer the bank's client after the year end date. The Committee discussed the matter and considered that it was not within the remits of the Committee. Nonetheless, it requested SSD to communicate the matter with the Hong Kong Association of Banks where appropriate.
