ABOUT THE WEBINAR

Audit Practice Manual ("APM"), which is designed to be used primarily in the audits of non-listed entities, aims to assist the practitioners in carrying out audit work efficiently and effectively. It adopts a risk-based approach in determining the extent of audit work required for an audit client. Audit programmes can be customized according to the risk assessed on each audit.

The revised APM, which was issued in November 2010, is updated to address the requirements of Clarified Hong Kong Standards on Auditing which are effective for audits of financial statements for periods beginning on or after 15 December 2009.

This webinar will introduce the overall structure of the revised APM and the impact of the new requirements under the Clarified Hong Kong Standards on Auditing on the revised APM and how they affect audit engagements. Pre-reading of the APM materials may be required for understanding the revised APM.

WHAT IS WEBINAR

A webinar is a web-based seminar transmitted over the Internet. Simply by connecting to the Internet, a webinar eliminates the barrier of location and brings speakers and participants together via voice and document sharing. No physical venue at the Institute for webinar and therefore no travelling is required.
