## About the Technology Forum Talk

In the digital age, "content" can be as easily copied and distributed as a click of a button. Digital Rights Management (DRM) is not only a hot buzzword, but also an important application of information security for digital media. DRM technology allows owners of digital content to protect against users making unauthorized copies. This technology lets enterprises persistently protect sensitive documents and emails no matter who has them or where they're stored. The document owners retain dynamic post-delivery control over the documents and reserve the rights to recall the documents at anytime anywhere. With the use of DRM, businesses are more comfortable in storing and sharing their confidential information electronically. DRM is relevant to financial, legal, technology and manufacturing industries, as well as o ther content businesses. This seminar will introduce the concepts, technology, and examine the applications of DRM, in particular, in control over the use and distribution of digital content in business applications. Applications of DRM will also be demonstrated.

Mr. Simon Liu is a Business Consultant at SecureNet Asia, where he is involved in deploying some of the major financial and banking security applications on the Internet.
