The Associate Director (AD) will assist the Deputy Chief Executive and the Director of the Education & Training Department in all matters pertaining to the Institute's Qualification Programme ("QP") and the overall examinations implementation under QP. This position is responsible for the development and quality assurance of QP, workshop delivery, training and recruitment of workshop facilitators and related student services. The post reports directly to the Director of the Education & Training Department and supports the Qualification and Examinations Board and other committees, panels and working groups.

Main job responsibilities include:

- developing strategies for implementing the QP in Hong Kong and Mainland China
- preparing study materials, workshop materials and examination paper for the assigned
 Professional Level Module and/ or Capstone Level of the QP
- managing the running of QP workshops, script marking process, recruitment / training of workshop facilitators and markers for the assigned module of the QP
- oversee the overall operations on QP examinations implementation
- leading the assigned strategic initiatives related to the development of QP
- providing coaching to managers on other QP examination papers if required

Qualifications and requirements:

- CPA with at least 10 years' post-qualification experience, preferably with some experiences in teaching accountancy subject and/ or providing training in CPA firms.
- Strong passion on developing the prospective CPAs with a good understanding of the QP Philosophy.
- Strong people management skills and able to negotiate at all levels both within and outside the organization.
