Deputy Director, Advocacy and Practice Development (Tax & Projects) (Ref: DD_APD 032021)

The Advocacy and Practice Development Department is responsible for policy and technical work in a range of areas, including taxation, insolvency and restructuring, forensic accounting, corporate governance, corporate finance, and anti-money laundering. The incumbent will take primary responsibility for taxation matters, while also assisting in other areas of work. Occasional travel to Mainland China and elsewhere outside Hong Kong.

Role and Responsibilities

- (1) Provide technical and administrative support and direction to committees and other technical/specialist groups, in particular supporting the Taxation Faculty Executive Committee, its China Tax Subcommittee and other sub-committees, and overseeing the day-to-day operation of the Taxation Faculty.
- (2) Conduct/ coordinate research and surveys, and assist in the development and management of other ad hoc technical and thought leadership projects.
- (3) Liaise with members and other internal and external stakeholders, including relevant government agencies, regulators and overseas organisations, as well as different departments within the Institute.
- (4) Support the director in relation to management of the department and deputise for the department head when required.
- (5) In relation to the Taxation Faculty and other committees, responsibilities may include:
 - Member support: coordinating activities and events, and issuing newsletters and updates.
 - Technical: reviewing and preparing responses to legislative and policy proposals, consultation papers and IRD interpretation and practice notes.
 - Stakeholder engagement: as indicated in 3 above

(6) Respond to technical enquiries on relevant subjects.

Qualifications and Required Attributes

- Degree holders and qualified professionals with a minimum of 10 years post qualification experience.
- Have initiative and be able to work independently, and be able to interact effectively with a range of senior professionals, government officials and others.
- Open-minded and adaptable, and have good analytical and organisational skills, as well as a sound knowledge of Hong Kong and, preferably also, cross-boundary taxation.
- Good communication skills, including a high standard of written and spoken English and Chinese and proficiency in Mandarin.
