- Developing strategies for implementing the QP in Hong Kong and Mainland China
- Preparing study materials, workshop materials and examination paper for the assigned Professional Level Module and/ or Capstone Level of the QP
- Managing the running of QP workshops, script marking process, recruitment / training of workshop facilitators and markers for the assigned module of the QP
- Driving the assigned strategic initiatives related to the continuous development of QP
- Providing coaching to managers on other QP examination papers if required

- CPA with at least 10 years' post-qualification experience, preferably with some experiences in teaching accountancy subject and/ or providing training in CPA firms.
- Strong passion on developing the prospective CPAs with a good understanding of the QP Philosophy.
