#### **Contents**

The two-day workshop focuses on the conduct of small to medium-sized engagements in compliance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing. Through instructor presentation, case illustration, classroom exercises and discussion, the course will cover:

- basic understanding of an audit conducted in compliance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing
- risk assessment and planning process under a risk-based audit approach
- appropriate audit procedures, including tests of controls and substantive procedures for common financial statements areas
- recoding of audit work in sufficient clarity and detail
- how to deal with audit findings and/or errors
- auditing of more complex and riskier areas: accounting estimates, using the work of an expert, group audits
- common issues on the applications of financial reporting standards
- review of financial statements

The workshops will be organized in an interactive learning mode. Participants will be guided to work through case illustrations and encouraged to discuss in group.
