Mr. Tsang Chung Wing – Global Financial Tsunami and Recession

The Institute is proud to present **Mr. Tsang Chung Wing (曾仲榮)**, Deputy Chief Editor and Chief Leader Writer of Hong Kong Economic Times, to talk to our members on the global financial tsunami and recession. In this talk, Mr. Tsang will look into the ripple effect across the financial markets and global economy caused by the subprime mortgage crisis in the U.S. Hong Kong, with its close relationship with the economy of the U.S. inevitably cannot escape from this financial turmoil. In order to tackle this critical situation faced by Hong Kong, it is important to know how we can sustain this financial tsunami and how this crisis can be turned into opportunity. Mr. Tsang will also talk about the “way-out” of Hong Kong in order to resist the economic downturn.

Mr. Tsang graduated from the Chinese University of Hong Kong with a Bachelor degree of Journalism. He has been engaged in media for over 20 years and responsible for news reporting and commentary.

Mr. Tsang is currently a part-time lecturer in School of Journalism and Communication in the Chinese University of Hong Kong and has taught the module on “Issues in Current Affairs” for 12 years. He is also a regular speaker at the City University of Hong Kong on current and contemporary affairs.
