3. 歌曲實戰 – 以經典歌曲作教材，令學生輕易學會一首歌。
4. 自彈自唱秘訣 – 旋律及拍子配合手口之協調。
5. 舞台技巧 – 器材運用及準備功夫，採排期間與技術人員 (Soundman) 溝通之術語。

課程特色

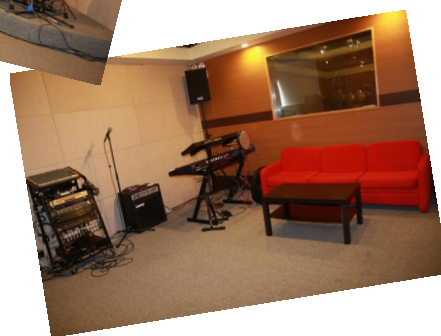
- 無需任何樂器演奏經驗，但對唱歌有基本認識之人士。
