About the programme and instructor

一首歌曲的完美表達，就是音樂和語言的結合，歌唱訓練並不單純是掌握聲音技巧，還必須把握語言規律，這樣才能在歌唱中既表現聲音的魅力和語言魅力，達到聲音美與語言美的統一。

課程主要分為兩部分，基礎練習及歌曲演繹。

1. 基礎練習

音階練習 - 利用不同咬字配合，讓學員發掘發聲位置；擴展個人音域，加強發聲及音準基本功。

呼吸運用 - 讓學員懂得正確呼吸方法及有關肌肉配合，以改善歌唱時「唔夠氣」的情況。

吐字技巧 - 每個字都是由一個音節組成的，而一個音節又可以把它分成字頭、字腹、字尾三部分，這三部分從語音結構來分。要想做到吐字清晰就要從這三方面入手加以訓練，不再成為歌唱發聲的障礙。

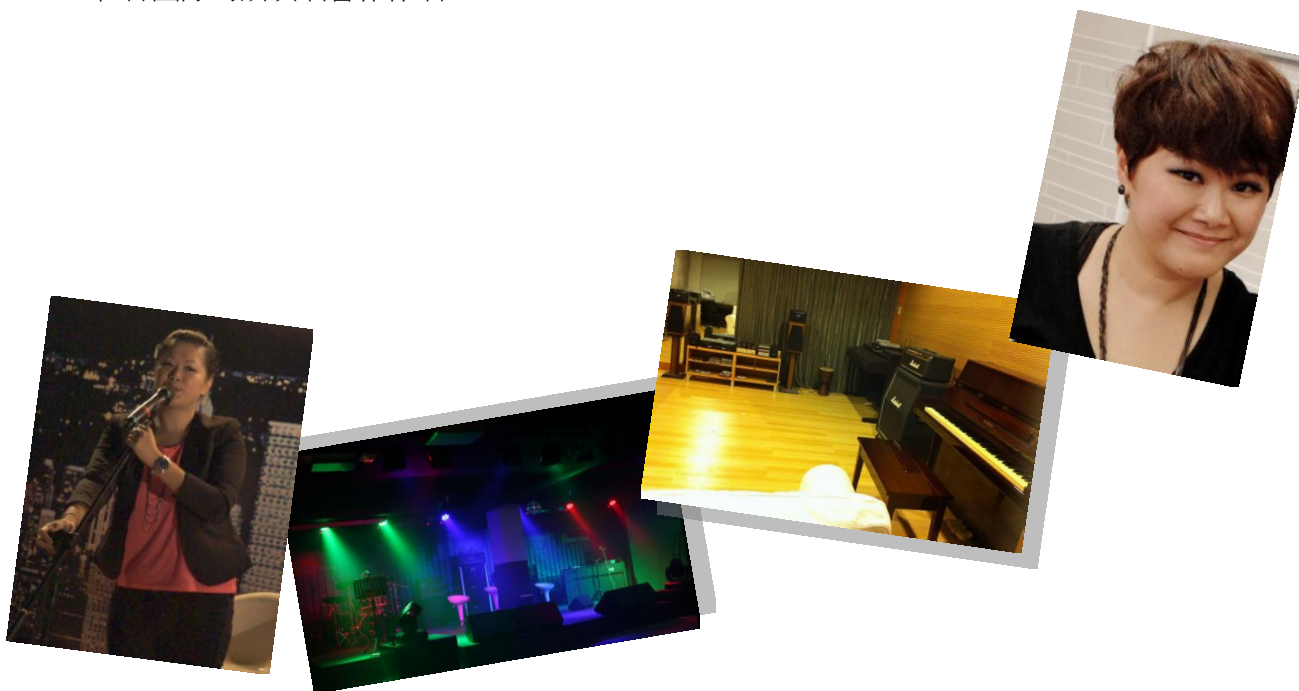
2. 歌曲演繹

加強學員對歌詞、對旋律及節奏的感悟。在你深刻理解歌曲以後，更宜於表達情感。學員透過交流及分析，令學員加深了解自己不足之處繼而改善及進步，達致完美歌曲演繹。

課程特色

- 無需任何歌唱經驗，適合初學人士。
- 完成課程 A 或 B 後，可獲邀請於 Music Stage 舞台參與演出 Student Mini Concert，享受實際舞台經驗。
