As the way forward, the profession is expected to establish internal policies, procedures and controls to cover customer due diligence and record keeping. **Failing to report knowledge or suspicion of crime proceeds or terrorist property is a criminal offence.**

Over 840 members had already attended these STR forums held last year to understand more about STR to protect themselves from unwittingly committing the related offences and how to keep away from the possible exploitation by money launderers and terrorist financiers.
