On 29 September 2013, the Chinese government established the Shanghai Pilot Free Trade Zone. It consists of four existing free trade zones - the Waigaogiao Free Trade Zone, the Waigaogiao Bonded Logistics Park, the Yangshan Bonded Port Area, and the Pudong Airport Bonded Logistics Centre.

With the aim of creating a more investor-friendly regulatory environment for businesses, the policies are likely to be replicated in other Chinese regions.
